This <u>all Fauré</u> program is headlined by the beautiful and serene **REQUIEM**, performed by the BCS chorus, with professional soloists and chamber orchestra.

Step away from daily headlines and stressors, as Fauré's elegant melodies and harmonies invite us to remember and celebrate those close to us.

"Cantique de Jean Racine" is an expansive hymn of praise that pleads "Banish the slumber of a weary soul." In "Pavane", the strut of a peacock's courtship dance teases young men and women dancing at a ballroom soiree. Other selections include "Élégie for Cello" [orchestral], "Ave Verum" [duet], and "Tantum Ergo."
