## The Bronx Concert Singers' 36th Annual Spring Concert

Bronx, NY – April 7, 2017 –On <u>Sunday afternoon, May 21, 2017 at 4:30 pm</u>, The Bronx Concert Singers, under the direction of Music Director Robert René Galván, will present our **36<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Concert** at St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church, 1891 McGraw Avenue, in Parkchester, Bronx, NY 10462.

Join the BCS Chorus, professional soloists and chamber orchestra for a performance of deeply moving works by 19th C. European master composers Verdi, Mahler, Boito and Gounod.

In *Stabat Mater*, Verdi's genius in word painting joins us viscerally to the heart of this monumental 13<sup>th</sup> C prayer: Mary, the Mother of Jesus, in anguish as she watches her son's death on the cross, and our own resonant sympathy while we also hope for salvation. Verdi wrote *Ave Maria* as an answer to a musical puzzle, creating a work that is both ethereal and timeless. His *La Vergine degli Angeli* from "La Forza del Destino" is a delicate farewell benediction that will warm your heart.

As a wedding gift for his bride, Mahler infused the *Adagietto* from **Symphony No. 5** with the depth, warmth, wonder, and vastness of his love for her. Close your eyes to sink into this lush work!

Goethe's Faust, the story of a scholar who sells his soul to the devil, has inspired countless offshoots. BCS's tribute to Faust features the *Prologue in Heaven* from Boito's **Mefistofele**, and two arias from Gounod's **Faust:**: lovelorn young Siebel's *Faites lui mes aveux* (*Flower Song*) and Faust's *Salut*, *demeure chaste et pure*.
